Few women callers doing square dances

ST. CATHARINES, Ont. (CP) — For 25 years, Orphie Easson of St. Catharines, Ont. has been calling square dances — and she is still one of the few women in the business.

A square-dancer all her life, Mrs. Easson began to call when she became involved in recreation leadership, first in rural organizations, then in the old community programs branch of the Ontario department of education.

Working in the office, she branched out into games and singing leadership as a hobby. Then she began calling simple dances she could remember. Without having been taught, she began to teach people to call.

"I seemed to remember every square-dance call I ever heard as a child," she said in an interview.

After her husband's death four years ago, she increased her work load. What began as a hobby developed into almost a full-time job.

In fall and winter she calls five or six times a week,

mostly evenings, besides teaching square dancing in some St. Catharines high schools, and calling for a senior citizens' afternoon group.

In summer, she works at a square-dancing course in New York state. She travels in Ontario and neighboring states and has attended festivals and conventions in Australia, New Zealand, Hawaii, England and continental Europe.

She does all the basic types of calling: The singing call (calling to the tune), the patter of hoedown call (like an auctioneer), and calling for round dances.

When she isn't calling, Mrs. Easson likes to dance "every time anyone asks me." It was only after her husband's death that she realized how much square dancing was geared to couples. It was a shock to find herself so engrossed in an activity where there was so little room for singles.

Every year she hears from women who want to square dance. It is a problem she would like to solve.

Bilingual settlement wanted by '78—Lang

MONTREAL (CP) — The aim of the federal transport department is to have full bil-

ingual air traffic control in Quebec by the end of 1978, Transport Minister Otto Lang said during the weekend.

Speaking on radio station CFCF, Mr. Lang said a full bilingual force would be "sufficiently complicated and could involve slightly different working conditions."

Members of Canadian Air Traffic Control Association oppose implementation of bilingualism on the grounds it constitutes a safety hazard. However, a two-week period of harassment tactics by pilots and controllers on both sides of the issue has ended.

"The problem involves personal relationships among people working together," he said. "And even now if I do anything that makes one group smile I can be assured the other will be frowning."

Turning to another language problem—the implementation of the Official Language Act in Quebec—Mr. Lang said the image of what the act stands for has led to "great misunderstanding in the rest of the country."

Scott new chief at VSE

VANCOUVER (CP) — Robert A. Scott, current chairman of the Alberta Securities Commission and a former vice-president of the Vancouver Stock Exchange, has been named president of the Vancouver exchange.

Dick Thompson, vice-chairman of the exchange's board of governors, made the announcement Thursday. He said Mr. Scott was the unanimous choice from 18 applicants considered by a VSE selection committee.

Mr. Scott, who assumes the position in September, succeeds Cyril White whose resignation takes effect Aug. 30. Mr. White resigned in June.

Mr. Scott said in a telephone interview that he knows "most of the players and the way the game is played—it will be a challenging job."

"The most immediate problem is to ensure that the rules and regulations of the

exchange and the Securities Act are observed by everyone—the member firms and their employees, promoters and the listed companies. I think the emphasis should be on the two latter groups."

The new president joined the Alberta Securities Commission in Edmonton in February, 1974 after serving as assistant vicepresident of administra-

tion and listings and then as vice-president of membership and compliance on the VSE.

Before joining the exchange he was with the B.C. Securities Commission (now the Office of the Superintendent of Brokers) as deputy superintendent. He also spent 10 years with a Calgary law firm, specializing in insurance litigation.
