Pilot rebuilds Lindbergh plane

BURLINGTON, Wis. (AP) — "I don't know how Lindy did it," Paul Poberezny said after he test flew a hand-built copy of Charles Lindbergh's airplane, the Spirit of St. Louis.

His reaction Tuesday was to Lindbergh's feat of flying nonstop from New York to Paris in 1927 and then taking his little airplane on a 22,000-mile barnstorming tour of 82 U.S. cities.

For the test flight, Poberezny, 56, stuffed his ears with cotton, but they were still ringing from the roar of the plane's 135-horsepower engine.

"The vision isn't good," said Poberezny, president of the Experimental Aircraft Association. "I kind of had to look out the left side to steer. I could feel the exhaust. The (carbon) monoxide in here was bad. We're going to have to get some air ventilation in there."

Poberezny was in the air five minutes, Lindbergh 33½ hours.

Hunt victim

NEW YORK (AP) — Yippee party pie-thrower Aaron Kay has claimed E. Howard Hunt as his latest victim.

Kay nailed Hunt in the head Wednesday evening with a coconut cream pie in the corridor of the RCA building here as the convicted Watergate conspirator was on his way to appear on NBC-TV's Tomorrow program.

Kay, whose previous claimed conquests have been columnist William Buckley Jr. and Senator Daniel Moynihan of New York, then showed up at the nearby offices of The Associated Press to say he "assaulted Watergate conspirator E. H. Hunt" because of Hunt's alleged ties to anti-Castro groups who had disliked and plotted against John Kennedy.

Hunt was released from prison Feb. 23 after serving 32 months of an eight-year sentence.

Price high

BAY CITY, Mich. (AP) — Some contestants in the Miss Nude Bay City contest paid a high price for competing. They wound up in jail, but only after the judges picked a winner.

The 19-year-old winner won a \$250 prize, which she might have to use to pay bail and hire a lawyer.

Police arrested her, two other contestants and a professional strip tease dancer for indecent exposure Monday night.

Stretching

LONDON (Reuters) — Iceland has "stretched" about 100 times more than usual during the last year, in one of the best demonstrations that Europe and America are drifting apart as the Atlantic Ocean widens, a

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report published Wednesday says.

Five Icelandic scientists writing in the science journal Nature say a major episode of geological activity began in north Iceland in December, 1975, and still was going on when they wrote their report in

December, 1976.

The spreading or stretching of Iceland was previously thought to have been going on at a rate of about 0.8 inches a year, but this was too small a distance to measure accurately. However, during the last year six feet of separation has been recorded.

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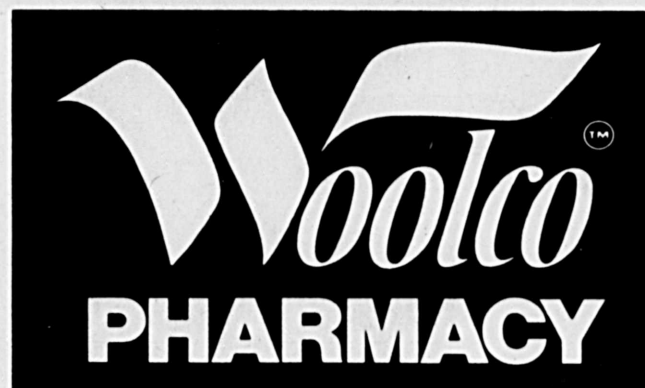
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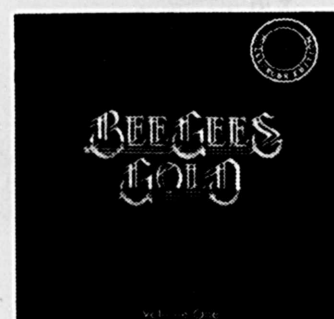
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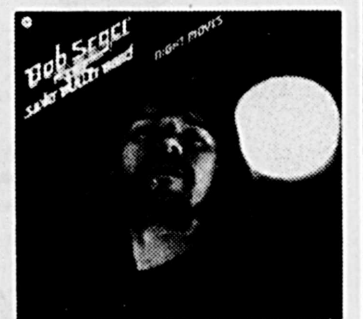
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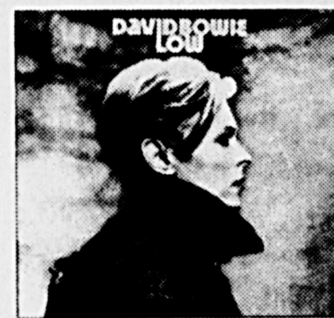
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
