## BARNABY JONES

In a dramatic two-hour episode of 'Barnaby Jones,' testimony Barnaby gave years earlier leading to the conviction of a kidnapping suspect comes back to haunt him when new evidence suggests the man may be innocent and his ex-wife calls in an hysterical state threatening to commit suicide. The episode will be rebroadcast Saturday, July 22, on CBS-TV.

Guest-starring are Bradford Dillman as Gordon Kingman, a marina land developer who profited from the crime when he was able to obtain property from the cash-depleted father of the victim, and Marj Dusay (pictured) as Jennifer Rhodes, a convicted kidnapper who has nursed a grudge against Barnaby since the trial.

Jennifer's bitterness, after her attempted suicide, remains unaffected by Barnaby's life-saving gesture but she provides a tip that gives him a valuable lead: the name of an author who saw a possible book in Rhodes' story and led Jennifer to believe he had uncovered important new evidence.
