"Narindar Singh Pawar, president of the Guru Gobind Singh Temple Association, said this week the temple at 443 Kelly Street needed more room for its 2,000 area members' activities.

Formerly called the Guru Nanak Cultural Association, the local membership will celebrate its first service informally on Sunday, Dec. 23.

The new temple structure, which includes the present one built in 1974, will include two levels and space for social affairs.

The addition will cost \$180,000 and by this time . next year Pawar says nine metal domes will be placed on the roof of the structure at a cost of another

in India in the 1600s. Pawar says Mayor Elmer Mercier will officiate at the opening of the temple at 11 a.m. Christmas


