## Ranchers, farmers set study

**VANCOUVER (CP)** — B.C. farmers and ranchers are planning an environmental study of their own in advance of one prepared by B.C. Hydro on the proposed Hat Creek coal-fired thermal plant in central B.C.

Don Knoerr, president of the B.C. Federation of Agriculture, said in a telephone interview from Prince George Tuesday that the proposed study will get under way in about two weeks and will be a joint venture of the federation and the B.C. Cattlemen's Association.

Both organizations are concerned about the environmental impact on ranching and farming in the Kamloops-Lytton-Ashcroft area if Hydro's proposed coal-fired thermal electricity generating plant goes ahead.

Knoerr said the farmers and ranchers have decided they want the study completed before the scheduled release in May of a revised Hydro impact study on the thermal project. "We want to use the study to identify answers before the questions in advance of Hydro's study," Knoerr said.

He said the group wants to be prepared for the public hearings which will follow Hydro's application for the proposed plant.

Knoerr said one of the concerns of his group is the hazard posed by acid rain from the Hat Creek plant.

Maurice Favell, head of Hydro's thermal generation project division, has said a boiled down version of Hydro's impact study will be released when the utility company formally applies for the project, possibly this spring.

# Shah's son makes vow

**CAIRO (AP)** — Reza Pahlavi, who has proclaimed himself the new shah of Iran, vowed Wednesday to begin a struggle to regain the throne and urged Iranian women to "break the chains of slavery laid upon them by fanatical reactionaries."

The 20-year-old Pahlavi

addressed his message to the women of Iran on the Jan. 7 anniversary of their Emancipation Day. The message was sent to news agencies.

Pahlavi, who took the title Reza Shaw II on his 20th birthday last Oct. 31, expressed confidence that a struggle against Iran's revolutionary Islamic

government "can end only in victory."

Referring to the strict codes imposed on Iran's women by the religious leader, Ayatollah Ruhollah Khomeini, Pahlavi said "constraints imposed at present on the Iranian woman result from a diabolic claim designed to exclude" her from her role in society.

A refresher course in English including fundamental skills in reading, writing and grammar. Pre-requisite: Basic Literacy in English or Engl. 010.

### Mathematics 020 - Basic Preparatory Mathematics\*\*

This course is a review of basic operations in whole numbers, fractions, decimals and percent. Pre-requisite: A basic familiarity with our number system.

### English 030 - Intermediate Preparatory English\*\*

Course topics include paragraph and theme writing, reading skills, business letters, composition, and literature. Pre-requisites: Engl 020 or Grade 9 English.

### Mathematics 030 - Intermediate/Preparatory Mathematics\*\*

This course includes an introduction to the metric system, ratio and proportion, roots and powers, manipulation of formulas. Pre-requisites: Grade 8 Mathematics or Math 020.

### Mathematics 040 - Advanced Preparatory Mathematics\*\*

This course includes a core of algebra, factoring, radicals, exponents, graphing, solution of linear, simultaneous, and quadratic equations and formulas, plus options which include analytical or practical geometry, trigonometry, vectors, logarithms, series and progressions and/or business topics.

### Biology 040 - Advanced Preparatory Biology\*\*

A lab-oriented course dealing with the basic elements of biology. It includes study of the microscope and other research tools, the cell, classification genetics, photosynthesis and respiration, ecology evolution, human biology or, botany or zoology. Pre-requisite: Science 030 or Grade 10 Science.

### Chemistry 040 - Advanced Preparatory Chemistry\*\*

This course covers such topics as atomic theory and structure, periodic table, nomenclature, chemical bonding, mole and weight, relations, acids, bases and salts, oxidation-reduction, solutions, gas laws, equilibrium, organic and biochemistry, nuclear chemistry and environmental chemistry. Lab work is a necessary and integral part of the course. Pre-requisite: Science 030 or Grade 10 Science.
