

Weekly newspapers top daily circulation

HALIFAX (CP) — Canada's weekly newspapers are riding a wave of growth and economic success that now gives them a greater combined circulation than that of daily papers, Jim Schatz, president of the Canadian Community Newspapers Association, said Wednesday.

However, strikes by postal workers and British Columbia pulp and paper workers are becoming a double-barrelled challenge for weeklies, especially those which depend on newsprint from the west coast, he said.

Schatz, owner of The Advance in Langley, B.C., was among 400 publishers and owners of weekly papers at the opening session of the association's annual meeting in Halifax.

He said in an interview the mail disruption has cut off the flow of money for many weeklies as well as the main distribution system for smaller ones.

The strike in British Columbia may soon force publishers in Western Canada to scramble for newsprint, he said, and the cost of buying it in the United States would be prohibitive.

Nevertheless, Schatz said weeklies are strong enough to survive the strikes. "We'll cope somehow because we've learned how to. We're past masters at it."
