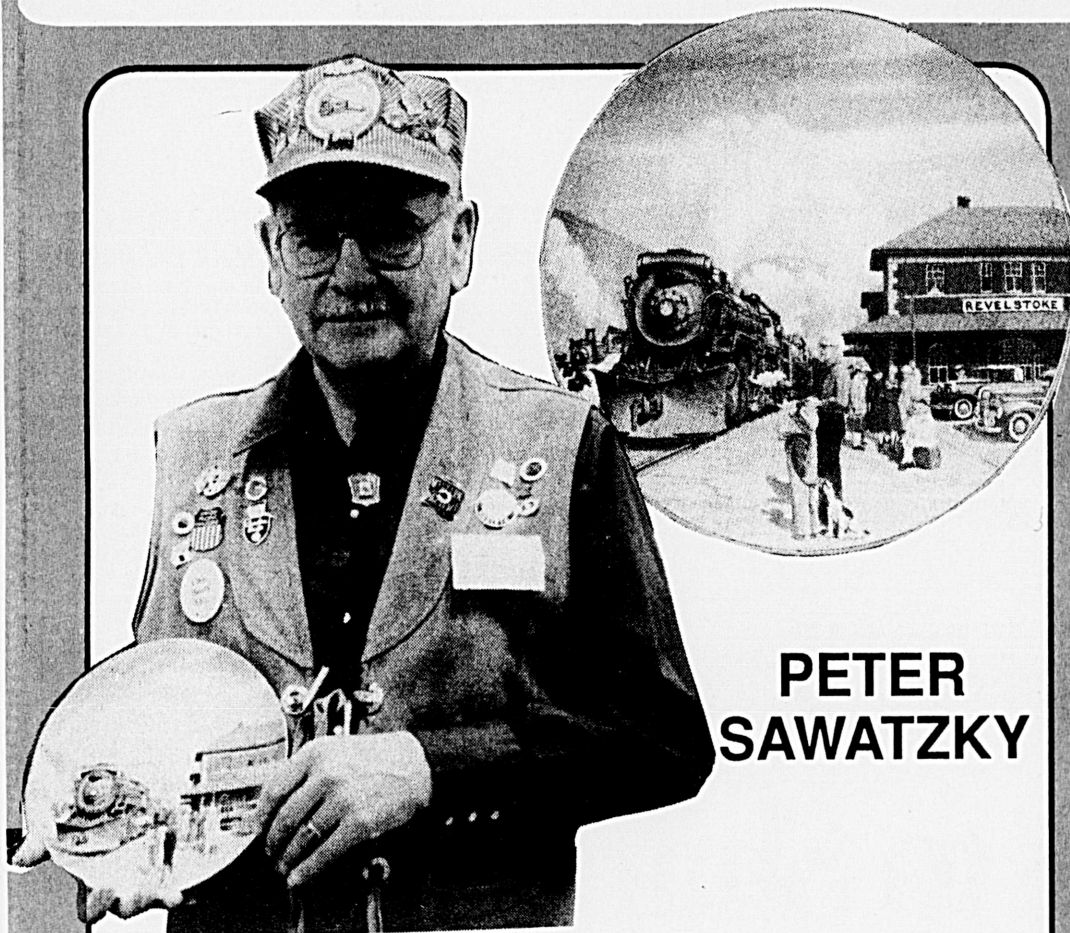

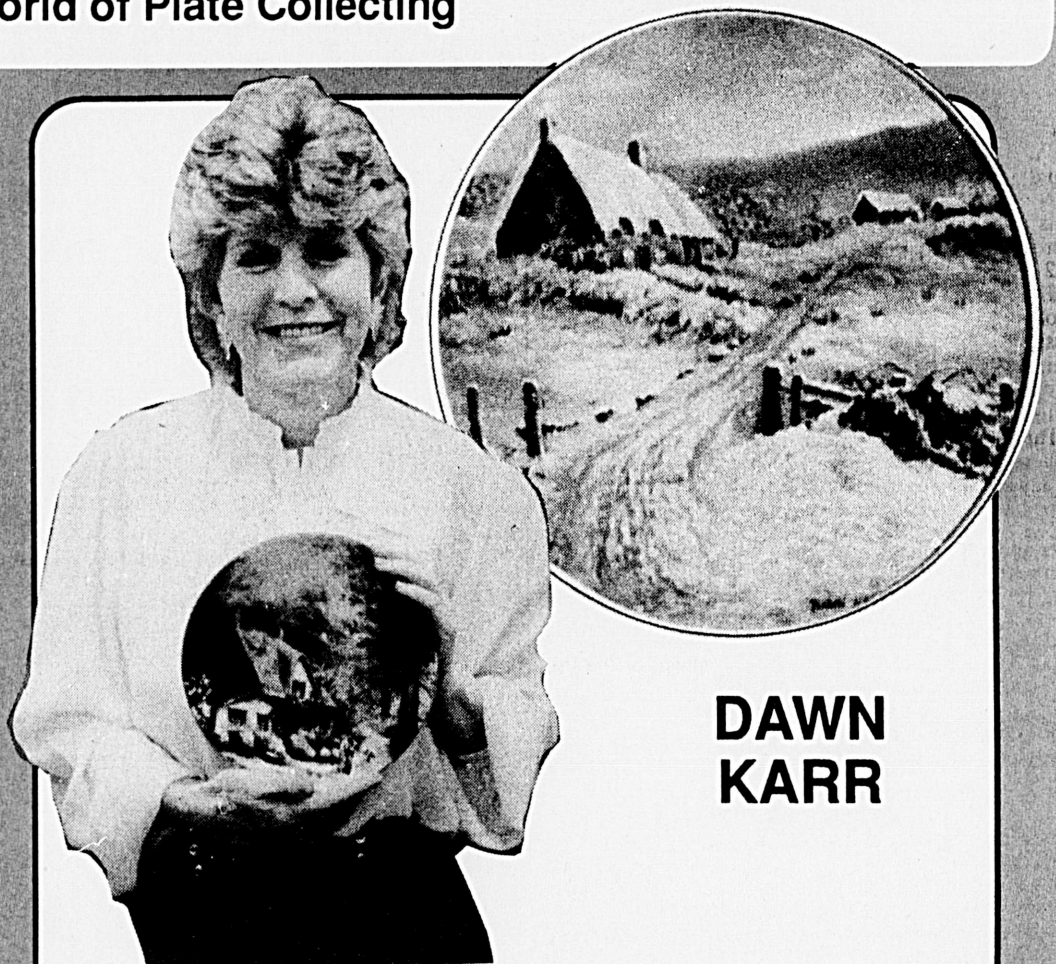
**PETER
SAWATZKY**

Germany-born Peter Sawatzky grew up in Chilliwack, B.C. and after an absence of 30 years is back, with his wife Eula, in that Fraser Valley community.

A versatile artist, his paintings hang in private collections throughout Canada, the United States and Europe. Included is 1/100 lithograph print of 'The Royal Train', presented to the Queen Mother to commemorate her cross-Canada railway tour. Her gracious letter of appreciation is one of his greatest treasures.

Peter's ability to catch the energy and drama of the steam trains of yesteryear has resulted in many commissions including one arranged by Greg Pepler of Winston Roland Collectors Plates. The first plate in a series of four, "Best Show in Town", features the Revelstoke Station.

The next series will feature CNR steam locomotives. Vintage cars found in Peter's railway prints will soon appear in a plate series of their own.



**DAWN
KARR**

Interested in art since childhood, Dawn Karr has worked in oils, watercolors, acrylics, pastels and is currently enjoying success in porcelain painting.

Influenced by Dave Reid of Reid's Art Materials in Vancouver and artist Tilly Milton, Dawn further developed her soft-edged nostalgic style as a result of a disastrous experience involving an attempt to have a valuable oil painting, The Cockfight, by G. Morley (grandfather of the famous English artist George Morley) restored. More than the old varnish was removed in the process. Studying the ruined painting, Dawn discovered the old technique used and adapted it to her own work, finding it worked especially well on plates.

Dawn is currently under contract with an international plate company, Winston Roland, of London, Ontario and will have four collector plates on the market by the end of 1990, in addition to limited edition prints of her cottage scenes.
