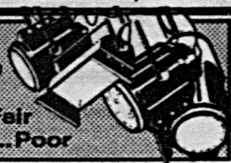

③ ★½ "Johnnie Mae Gibson: FBI" (1986, Drama) Lynn Whitfield, Howard E. Rollins Jr. Fact-based story of a Southern woman who overcame a poverty-stricken childhood and the strains of balancing a marriage and a career to achieve her ambition of becoming an FBI agent.

② ★½ "The Disappearance of Flight 412" (1974, Mystery) Glenn Ford, Bradford Dillman. When two jets tracking a UFO mysteriously vanish from the radar screen, an Air Force colonel finds that the government is strangely quiet about the matter.

② ★★ "Dead and Buried" (1981, Horror) James Farentino, Melody Anderson. A New England policeman investigates a series of bizarre murders where the "victims" don't seem to stay dead.
