Where did actresses get their start?

Q. My father-in-law says Goldie Hawn and Judy Carne were on "Saturday Night Live." I say they were with "Hee Haw" years ago. Who's right? - L.B., Little Rock, Ark.

A. Neither. Goldie and Judy both burst into the public's favor on Rowan and Martin's "Laugh-In."

Q. Please tell me the last name of the host of "Family Feud." My brother says it is Cole, and I say it is Combs. Which one is correct? - M.C., New Bern, N.C.

A. You're the big winner. His name is Ray Combs.

Q. I would like to have the name of an old movie that starred Stewart Granger and Wendell Corey. The setting was either Canada or Alaska, and Corey was a policeman and Granger a fugitive. Is it on VCR? - M.J.C., Houston

A. That was called "The Wild North," and it dates from '52. Cyd Charisse was involved, too.

Q. Please settle an argument for me. What was John Wayne's first film? I say it is "Stagecoach." - M.C., Hot Springs, Ark.

A. You're only off by about 65 films. His first was "Hangman's House" in '28. "Stagecoach" didn't come along until '39. In between, he made 65 others.

Q. I admire the work of ABC newsmen Forrest Sawyer. I

know a bit about his professional background, but not much about him personally. Can you fill in some details? - D.H., Cincinnati

A. Non-professional stuff about Sawyer: He was born in Lakeland, Fla., and his early ambition was to do something in the religious field. To

that end, he studied religion and Eastern philosophy at the University of Florida, but, while doing graduate work at the University of Texas at Austin, he became interested in communications. He began working in radio in various stations in Florida, then Atlanta, then Boston and onto network TV with CBS and then, eventually, was wooed away by ABC.

Q. I read a book - I think the

title was "Overboard" - in which a couple was crossing the Pacific in a sailboat. The woman falls out, the man searches the ocean for her, finally finds her, jumps out to rescue her, and they drown in each other's arms. One day, I turned on the TV and saw the last five minutes of a movie, and there is Angie Dickinson playing that part, in the process of drowning in her rescuer's arms. This is not the "Overboard" starring Goldie Hawn? What is the name of that movie? - V.P., Stuart, Fla.

A. Amazingly, it, too, is "Overboard." It was a TV movie in '78, with Ms. Dickinson and Cliff Robertson. There is no VCR available.
