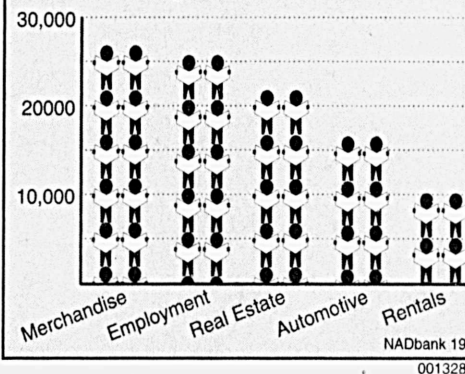

ROSS — Ivan Sinclair Ross, born 1910, Moosejaw, Sask., and raised in the Qu'Appelle Valley. His father James was killed in WWI. Ivan attended the University of Saskatchewan. His studies interrupted by the depression and WWII, he later completed his degree at U.B.C. As a young man in the depression, he crossed the country by rail and motorcycle, surviving by panning for gold near Prince George, B.C. In WWII he was in the RCAF and a member of 413 Tusker Squadron stationed from 1942-1944 in Ceylon. He was enroute to London by boat when D-Day was declared. On his arrival in Britain in August, 1944, he met his future wife Stevie, and their marriage the following January lasted 51 years. On his return to Canada, Ivan worked by necessity at a variety of jobs - in a sawmill, fishing with "Uncle Bill" (writer Bertrand W. Sinclair), and as a mechanic. After settling in Prince George in 1950, he proved in his forties that you can teach an old dog new tricks by becoming a high school teacher, and taught in Prince George from 1950-1975, then retiring to the Okanagan.

As a little boy, Ivan's nickname was Sunny. His disposition remained that to the end of his days, in his even-temperament, his corny jokes, and his smile. He had an endless curiosity, which arced from observing first-hand the migration of native tribes in the early century, to fascination with cyberspace in 1995. He was pleased in his later years to reconnect with the remaining members of his Tusker Squadron. He was a voracious and wide-ranging reader, from Equinox and The Atlantic Monthly to Proust's epic novel, which he finished reading in his seventies.

With him when he died peacefully in Penticton Hospital on October 25, 1995, were his wife Stevie, son Jim and daughter Heather. He is also survived by his granddaughter Juniper, a brother Murdoch in Australia, sister Ruby in Vancouver, and was predeceased by his brother Donald. He is survived by numerous nieces and nephews.
