Missing Canadian may have fallen from boat

NASSAU, Bahamas (AP-CP) — A Canadian woman remained missing Monday after her disappearance from a cruise ship off the Bahamas was reported by her hus-

A U.S. Coast Guard plane and Bahamian naval boats searched in vain Sunday for Jill Begora, 59, who was reported missing by her husband, Dennis Begora, a St. Catharines, Ont., dentist Saturday morning as the Royal Caribbean cruise ship Jewel of the Seas pulled into Nassau, the Bahamian capital.

The ship's crew filed a missing persons report with the coast guard after a search of the vessel turned up no sign of Begora, U.S. Coast Guard spokesman Dana Warr said. "They did a full ship search and there was no evidence that she had left the ship in Nassau," leading authorities to believe she may have fallen overboard, Warr said.

No reprieve for gang founder

SAN FRANCISCO (AP) - Gov. Arnold Schwarzenegger refused to block the execution of Stanley Tookie Williams, rejecting the notion that the founder of the murderous Crips gang had atoned for his crimes and found redemption on death row.

With a federal court refusing to grant a reprieve, Williams, 51, was set to die by injection at San Quentin Prison early Tuesday for murdering four people during two 1979 holdups.

Williams' case became one of the country's biggest death-row cause celebres in decades. It set off a countrywide

debate over the possibility of redemption on death row, with Hollywood stars and capital punishment foes arguing that Williams had made amends by writing children's books about the dangers of gangs.


islators reinstated the death penalty in

He was condemned in 1981 for gunning down convenience store clerk Albert Owens, 26, at a 7-Eleven in Whittier and killing Yen-I Yang, 76, Tsai-Shai Chen Yang, 63, and the couple's daughter Yu-Chin Yang Lin, 43, at the Los Angeles motel they owned. Williams claimed he was innocent.

Just before the governor announced his decision, the 9th U.S. Circuit of Appeals denied Williams' request for a reprieve, saying there was no "clear and convincing evidence of actual inno-

But Schwarzenegger suggested Monday that Williams' supposed change of heart was not genuine, noting that the inmate had not owned up to his crimes or shown any real remorse for the countless killings committed by the Crips.

"Is Williams' redemption complete and

sincere, or is it just a hollow promise?" Schwarzenegger wrote less than 12 hours before the execution.

Without an apology and atonement for these senseless and brutal killings, there can be no redemption."

Williams' supporters were disappoint-

ed with the governor's refusal to commute the death sentence to life in prison without parole.

"The governor's 96-hour wait to give an answer was a cowardly act and was tortuous," said former MASH star Mike Farrell, a death penalty opponent.
