Ron Berezan will give a public presentation on growing food in urban areas on Friday evening, 7 p.m. start, and a workshop on creating a natural, sustainable and edible landscape on Saturday morning, from 9 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

Both events will be held at the Prince George Public Library's main branch, in the Keith Gordon room.

Admission is by non-perishable food item for the Friday evening presentation and \$35 for the Saturday morning workshop.

Tickets are available at the Recycling and Environmental Action Planning Society (REAPS) office at 1950 Gorse St.

Berezan's Friday presentation will explore a range of models for growing food in urban areas from private yards, to public spaces to community projects and more.
