## Tool needed to fight hate crimes: RCMP

implementation of some limitation to free speech through denial of access to public space, according to provincial hate crimes team member Les Flewelling, in town to speak in support of the task

"There needs to be a tool to stop those people, especially when they are known to the law enforcement community," says Corporal Flewelling.

It's a matter of balancing the threat to public safety posed by protests that greet knowingly hateful groups against the right to free speech, he says.

It's also about upholding the community standards of the majority, while maintaining respect for diversity and the rights of minority groups

"That's precisely why we have the Charter of Rights and Freedoms," argues the BCCLA's Mr. Westwood, "to protect the minority on the fringes of society from being disadvantaged because of their lifestyle or opinions.

Mr. Westwood says the BCCLA will evaluate the task force's recommendations before deciding if it will intervene in the implementation of them as official city policy.

City council unanimously endorsed "in principle" the task force report's four main recommendations.

It will not become policy, however, before reviews and fine-tuning have been completed.

Other recommendations in the task force on hate activities report: that Prince George designate itself a "hate-activities free zone"; that the city continue and expand its intercultural committee; that city council demonstrate leadership in regards to ongo ing education of community leaders and others in the community; and that the city demonstrate leadership through proactive measures such as creating a hate-free workplace, allocating proper resources to respond to hate activities, and encouraging investigations by the Attorney-General's Ministry and the Human Rights Commission into complaints about discrimination
