

Council NOTES

Fireworks coming

Head to Carrie Jane Gray park for some sparkle on New Year's Eve. The city is allowing Gateway Christian Ministries to hold a 15-minute fireworks display at the park as long as they provide an insurance certificate and fireworks permit to city council by December 29.

Hospice cleared

City council approved variance permit from the Prince George Hospice Society after the society agreed to increase the parking at the site from four to 22 spaces.

The permit was contested by some neighbours of the house on Clapperton Street, who were concerned about street parking and safe access to Ferry Avenue.

Sewer signed off

Residents of Bunce and Heyer Road Subdivision will be getting improvements to their water and sewer system whether they want it or not. City councillors unanimously approved the improvement project even though almost half of the neighbours petitioned against the cost of the project to each homeowner after a provincial grant.

Access for the poor

City councillors voted to reestablish a policy that would allow thousands of needy Prince George residents access to city programs, skating and swimming.

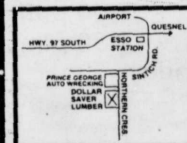
