well as full event coverage.

"We're going to try to provide a feed that is, first and foremost, fair," Brannigan says. "There will be no host-country bias, and we'll appeal to the passionate track and field fan with every sport covered."

Brannigan is executive producer of CBC's Canadian coverage, where national bias is desirable.

"Our job is to take those (host broadcaster) feeds and tell the Canadian story, but not only the Canadian story. In many ways, our job is to educate, to tell as many stories as we can and as many personal stories as we can."

Mixed in with the event coverage, Brannigan says, will be regular "Essence of Athletics" segments, hosted by Gowan and looking back on some of the high points in track and field history.

"Mostly we'll be programming wall-to-wall track and field, because that's what this event is all about. For the passionate fan, there will be lots of athletics. For the casual viewer, we'll offer a lot of added value, to tell them what this is all about."

Even the most casual viewer will know some of the marquee names, especially in the glamour events.

And of course, the most glamorous are the 100-meter sprints. These should feature the fastest man and woman alive: Maurice Greene and Marion Jones of the United States. (At this writing, it was uncertain if Bruny Surin or Donovan Bailey would be

healthy enough to pose a threat.)

For Canadians, other events to watch closely are the men's 1,500 meters, which Brantford, Ont., native Kevin Sullivan won at the Grand Prix in Osaka, Japan, in May; the discus, in which Londoner Jason Tunks won back-to-back Grand Prix honors; and the high jump, where Canadians Mark Boswell and Kwaku Boateng are expected to compete with world record-holding Cuban Javier Sotomayor and first- and second-ranked Russians Vyacheslav Voronin and Sergey Klyugin.

To take maximum advantage of this international showcase, one of the most popular events, the marathon, will be matched with the opening ceremonies -- giving those 4 billion TV viewers a guided tour of Edmonton.

Perhaps taking their cue from the spectacular coverage Sydney, Australia, got during the 2000 Summer Olympics, the organizers have scheduled the men's marathon to coincide with the startup festivities. Along with the pageantry, viewers will see superhumans pounding out 30 kilometers of pavement. The route will showcase the best of the city: the North Saskatchewan River Valley, the University of Alberta, the business district, Chinatown, the provincial legislature and -- of course -- West Edmonton Mall.

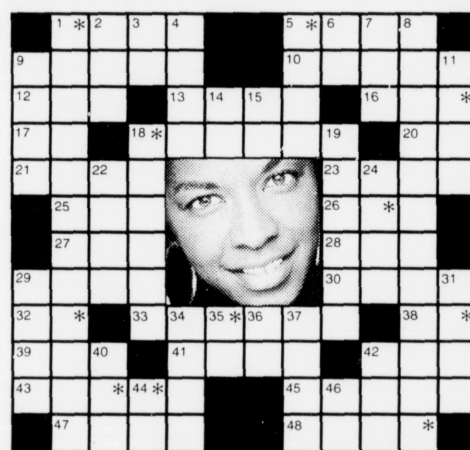
As Brannigan says, they don't call the place the City of Champions for nothing. "And this is another notch in their belt. They hosted the Commonwealth Games (1978), the World University Games (1983). ... They're used to big events like this."

TV**CROSSWORD**

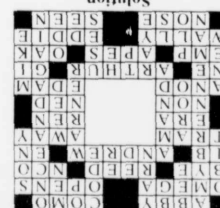
