of segments offering a behind-the-scenes look at the Calgary Flames training camp with announcer Kelly Hrudey, a former NHL goaltender.

This five-part series (running on consecutive "Saturday Nights") isn't, strictly speaking, a 50th-anniversary special. But it will, Darling says, offer fans a "unique behind-the-scenes view" of a modern hockey organization.

Hrudey, 40, admits he has "worked out maybe 30 times" since he retired from the NHL three years ago. But, rather than just go into the Flames camp and report on it, he is going to compete for a goaler's berth on the team roster-facing 100 mph slapshots from players half his age. He started training in the late spring for the punishment his body would take.

His wife and three daughters "did razz me a bit about being an old guy," he says. "I think they're a bit puzzled about why I'm doing this."

He makes it clear that this is a reporting job, and not another hockey comeback.

"I'm asking myself, 'Why does my body feel this poor when I'm in peak physical condition?' This is clearly not a comeback, and never could I be talked into one. I love my broadcasting job and take it very seriously."

"Because of my experience, maybe I could compete for one week at the NHL level," Hrudey says, "but my performance would drop off pretty quickly."

Meanwhile, Darling says he is planning to mine the "HNIC" tradition through the season,

"but we're not going to drill it into people's heads."

"Our plan through the year is to do things tastefully, where they need to be done in bits and pieces, and subtly."

The show's producers have been going over old tapes, looking as much for great announcer moments - from Danny Galiani, Dick Irvin, Bob Cole, Howie Meeker, Ron MacLean and the inimitable Don Cherry - as for the great plays and players.

There even will be a contest where people can submit their own special versions of the "HNIC" theme song. The producers expect to hear everything from high-school bands to "punk versions, to some guy with a comb and a piece of wax paper."

Now, as for the show never having jumped the shark ...

A TV series "jumps the shark" at the moment it slides into self-parody. The term was coined for an episode of "Happy Days" in which Fonzie went water skiing and jumped over a shark - instantly turning himself from the personification of cool into the original hipster doofus.

There's no scientific way of measuring these things but there is, of course, a Website: [www.jumptheshark.com](http://www.jumptheshark.com).

Most fan comments echo this one: "'HNIC' has never, and will never, jump the shark. As long as they keep the theme song (Canada's second national anthem) and the doubleheader, it will never jump."

A straw poll on the same site has produced a 22-9 decision that "HNIC" is surfing into its second half-century without a dorsal fin in sight.

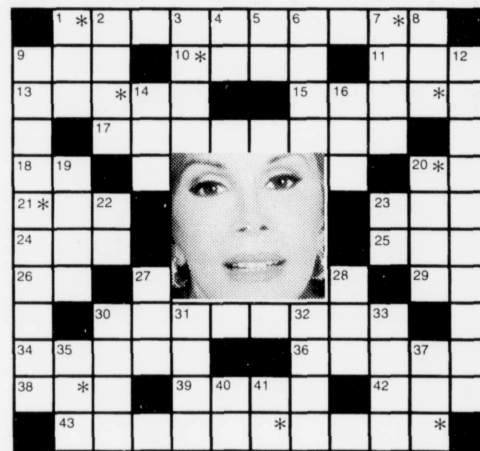
