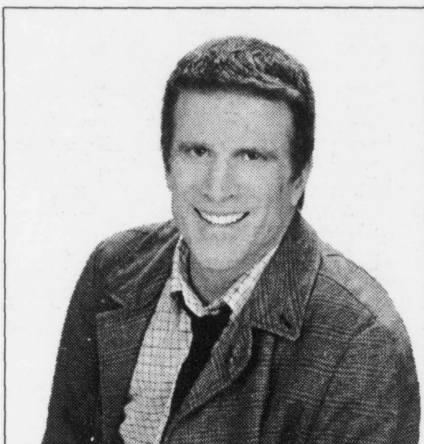

witnesses perjured themselves and evidence was suppressed. Not surprisingly, Cross (Currie Graham, "ER") was absolved of all blame.

The film, co-produced with the Aboriginal People's Television Network, tells the story from the native point of view. It focuses on the anger of Harper's half-brother (Eric Schweig) and the compassion of his father (Gordon Tootoosis).

They present an interesting microcosm of the clash between white and native concepts of justice: The young man, an urban native, wants retribution and the old man, on the reserve, wants healing. Harper is played in flashback by Adam Beach ("Windtalkers").

"We wanted to make a film about the native side of it," Bailey says. "The easy way was to make a film about the police and what happened to Cross and what happened to Dowson. But that wasn't the story we wanted to tell. We wanted to tell how it affected the Harper family."

Police harassment is a fact of life for native people who live in Prairie cities, where they form a large and visible underclass. And the type of thing that happened to Harper is still going on - as can be seen with the current investigation of the Saskatoon police department.

"What the J.J. Harper story did was it forced the issue," Bailey says. "People are aware, but people put their heads in the sand ... Natives know what's going on. Natives

know that they can't walk down the street without some cop hassling them.

"But you're not going to get change from people unless you force it, and that's what the J.J. Harper issue did."

The inquiries into Harper's killing finally revealed the cover-up, and it uncovered an institutional racism in the Winnipeg police force.

When his role in the cover-up was revealed, Dowson committed suicide. Cross eventually quit the police department and died an alcoholic in the late 1990s. The police chief was forced to resign.

Since those traumas, the Winnipeg force has tried to rehabilitate its image and improve relations with the native community. As a result, the very organization that is skewered in "Cowboys and Indians" helped Bailey make her film. They supplied uniforms and a police car from their museum, and even offered to let Bailey shoot at police headquarters.

"They're trying to do better," Bailey says. "And they also feel that happened a long time ago, that they have changed, and that things are getting better within the police force. I would say they believe it wouldn't happen again."

After living with the J.J. Harper story, Bailey doesn't share that optimism.

"No, I don't believe it wouldn't happen again," she says. "Look at what's happening in Saskatchewan, with the inquiry about the death of the kids who got dropped off by cop cars on the edge of town. That was last winter."

"To say everything's fine would be ludicrous."

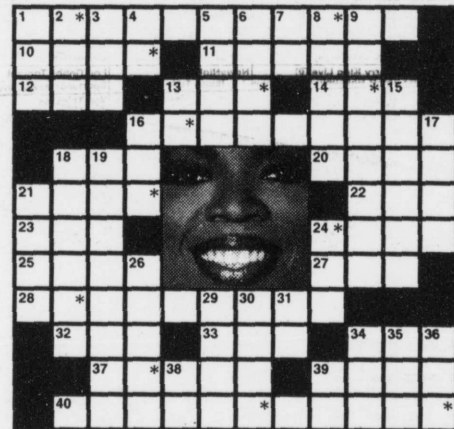
