The Prince George Snowmobile Club has completed a new snowmobile trail connecting the south end of Prince George, near Park Ridge, with the network of trails south of West Lake.

A small crew worked on the trails this year doing mostly brushing to open up old logging roads and trails, says Bob Gray, Trail Director for the West Division of the PG Snowmobile Club.

Dave Ceaser, also from the snowmobile club, helped clear the connector trail this year. He says the trail gives riders a new route that does not cross plowed roads nor private property.

Ceaser explains that in past years some riders have used the Domano Road extension to get to West Lake. However, riders are cautioned to stay off this route, as it passes through the Red Rock Tree Nursery and can impact the trees.

A small groomer will be used to maintain the connector trail this year, says Ceaser.

WEST LAKE TRAILS

The main access point to West Lake Trails is via Moose Springs Resort, formerly Baldy Hughes, located off of Blackwater Road. The resort is on the left (east) side of the road, 26 kilometres from the highway turnoff.

The resort has ample parking, a general store, a restaurant and overnight accommodations. The resort is centrally located with trails extending in many directions.

The West Lake trails are considered easy to moderate, and are well suited for beginners. Also, the club maintains the trail network with a grooming machine.

"We try to make [the trails] family oriented," says Bob Gray, adding that there are also places to stop and have a picnic.

Anyone interested in learning more about this area should join the Prince George Snowmobile Club. Memberships are reasonably priced and helps support the development of snowmobiling in this area. There are monthly meetings held the first Tuesday of each month at the clubhouse, located at the end of Scott Road. Meetings begin at 7 PM.

CROSS COUNTRY SKI TRIPS


