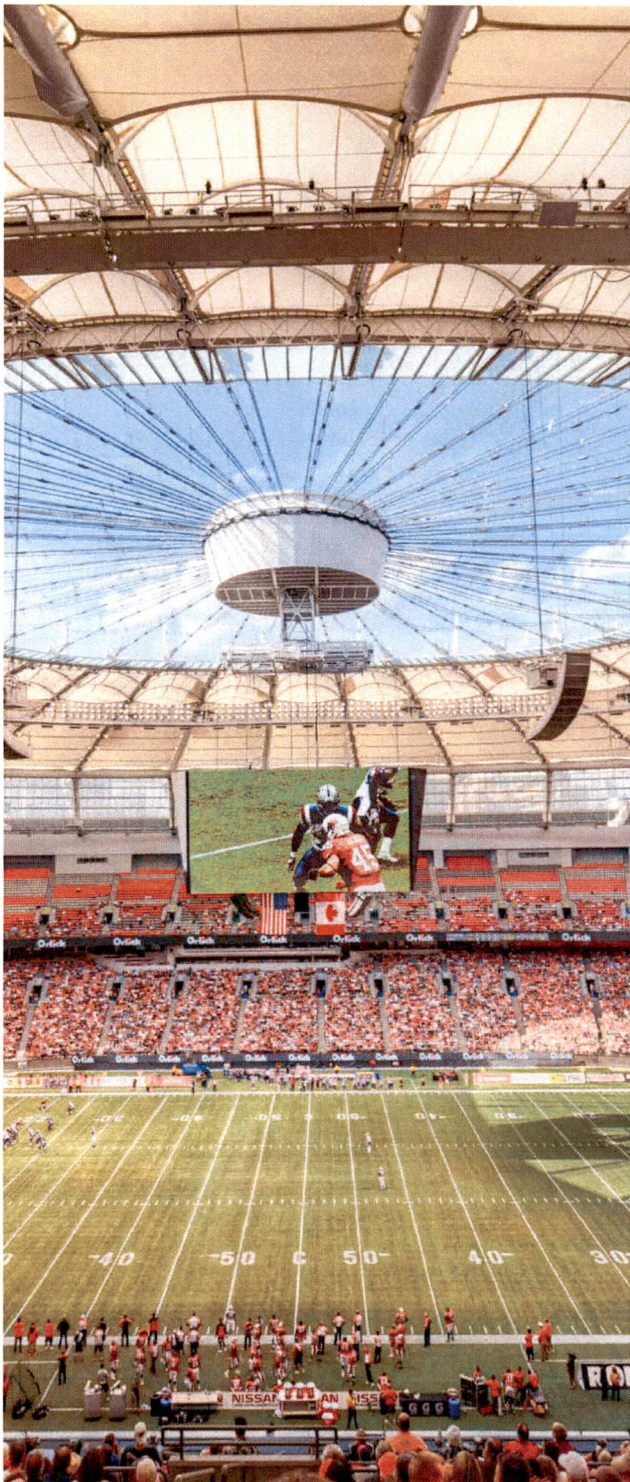


WHY YOU SHOULD GO TO A LIVE BC LIONS HOME GAME!
