

There seemed to be a pervasive atmosphere of disappointment which loomed over the rally; speakers acknowledged the racial divisions that had been exposed. They expressed their uncertainty for the future admitting that "More than we'd like to admit we still have a ways to in Canada go before we can live in harmony."

Currently the Boushie family are fighting for a federal appeal.

Speakers at the rally also called out Justin Trudeau on his low prioritization of Indigenous issues, and to follow through on his campaign promises of true reconciliation, preserving indigenous rights, and investigating missing women on the Highway of Tears.
